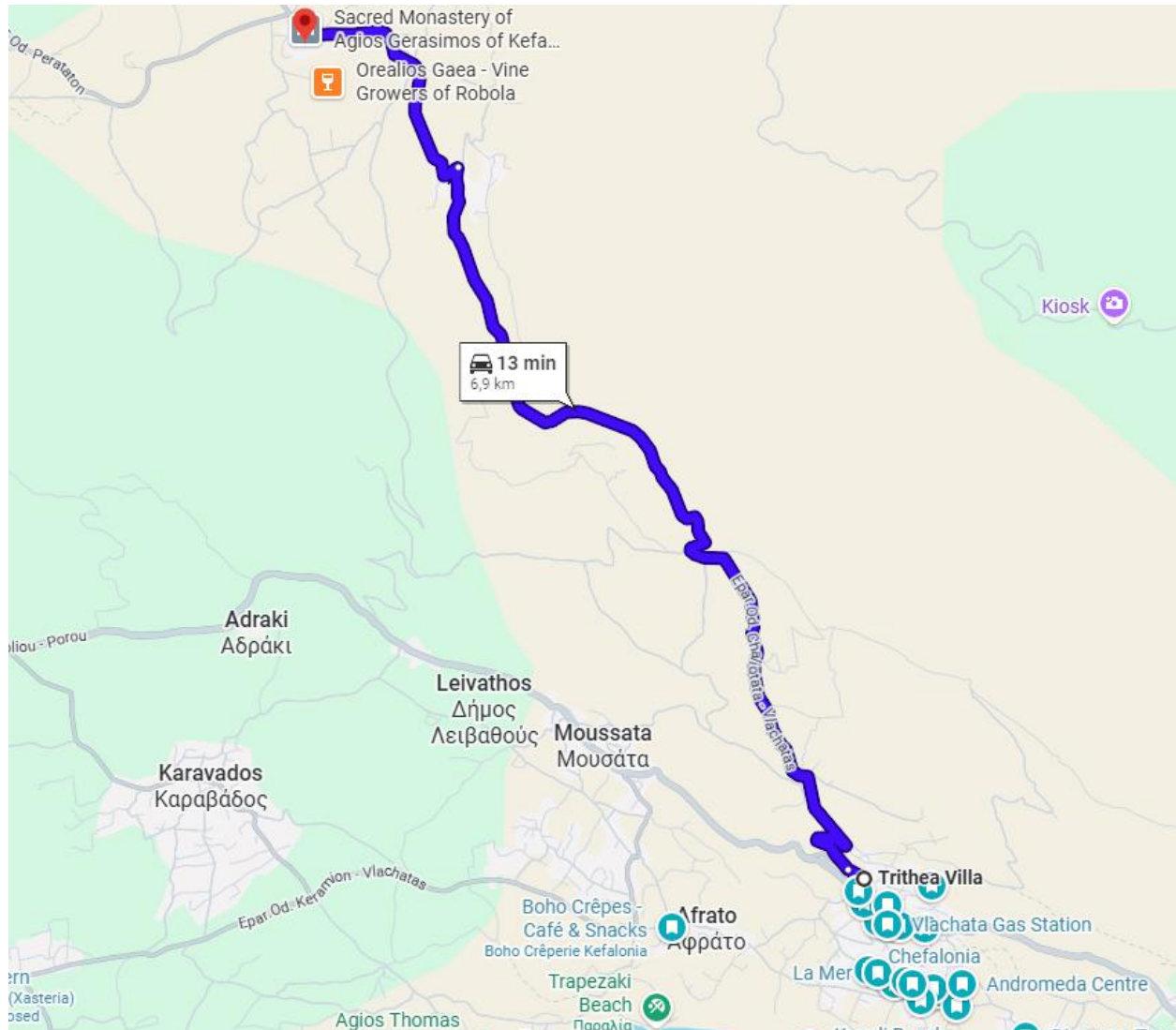


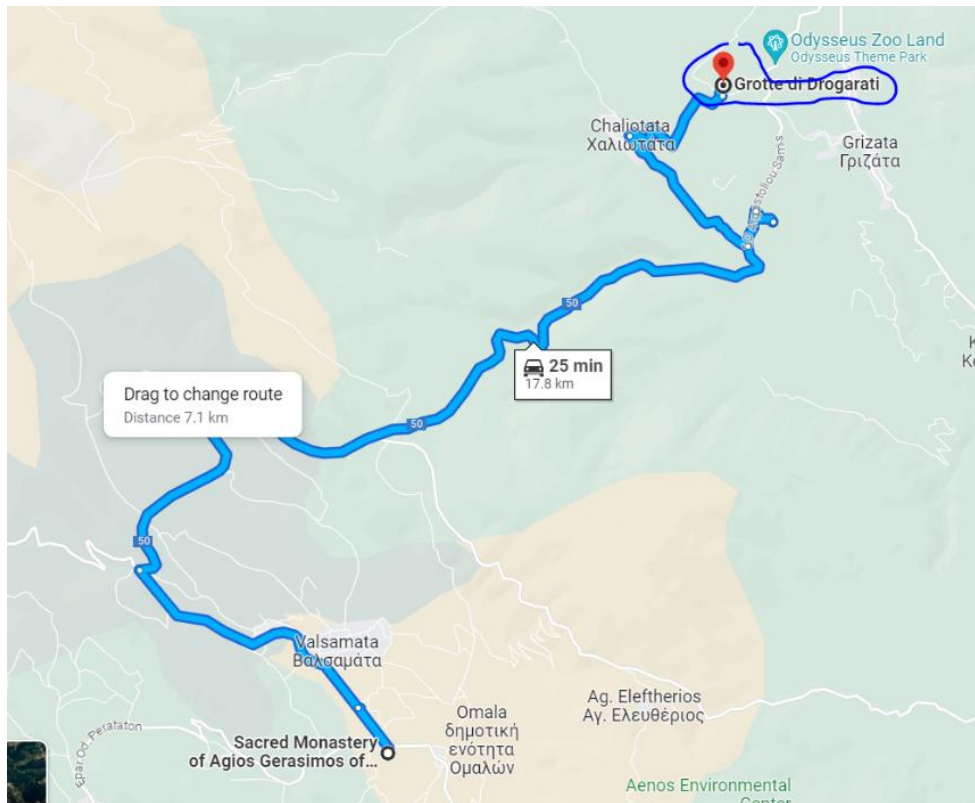
Proposal Trip 1 - North Kefalonia & Highlights

On this day trip, you'll experience a mix of **monasteries, caves, lakes, and a beautiful beach**.

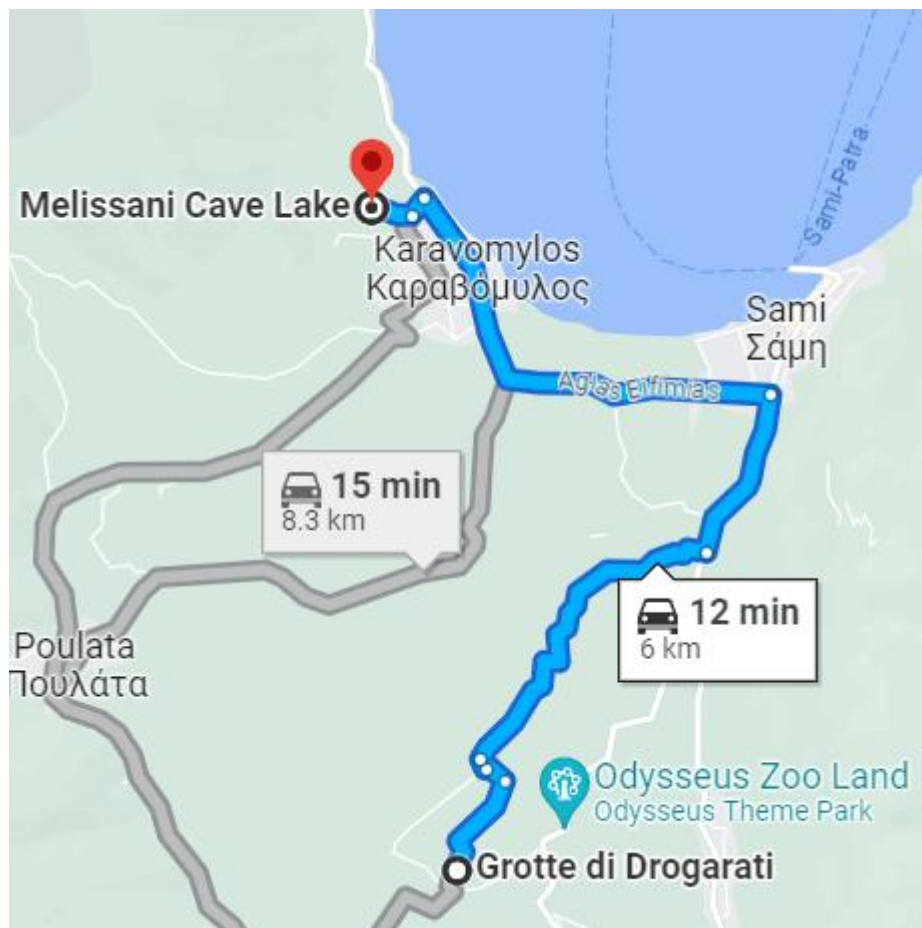
I recommend starting your day with a visit to **Saint Gerasimos Monastery**. You can enter the cave where he used to pray. Take a moment to make your own prayer — and believe me, you may feel something special. I'm not particularly religious myself, but I've seen very positive signs in my life after visiting and praying there. It's worth a try.



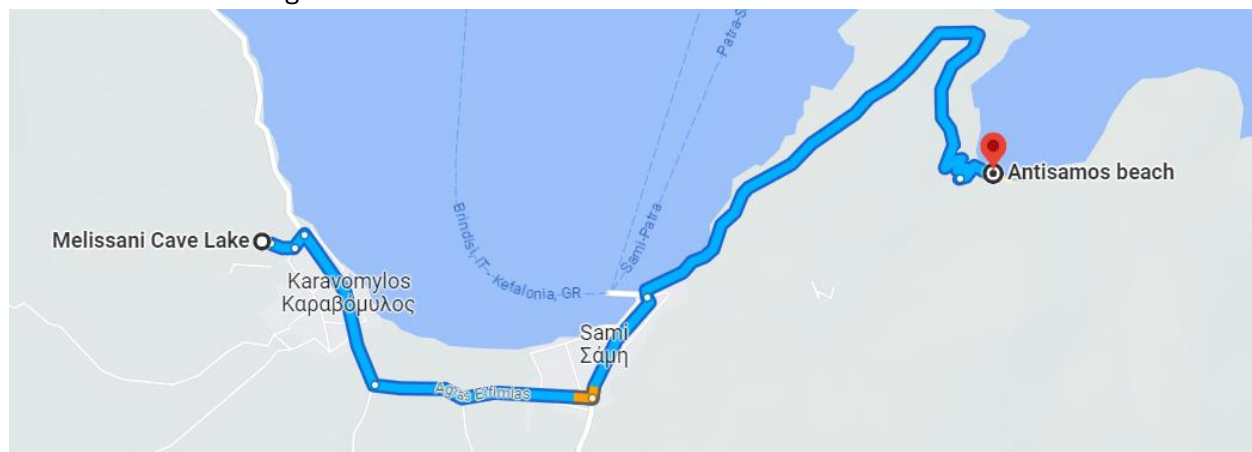
Next, visit **Drogarati Cave**. This impressive underground cave is worth seeing. Nearby, there's a new thematic park called **Odysseus Zoo Land**. It's mainly recommended for young children who are familiar with Greek mythology. I haven't visited it myself, but friends have told me it's best suited for kids.



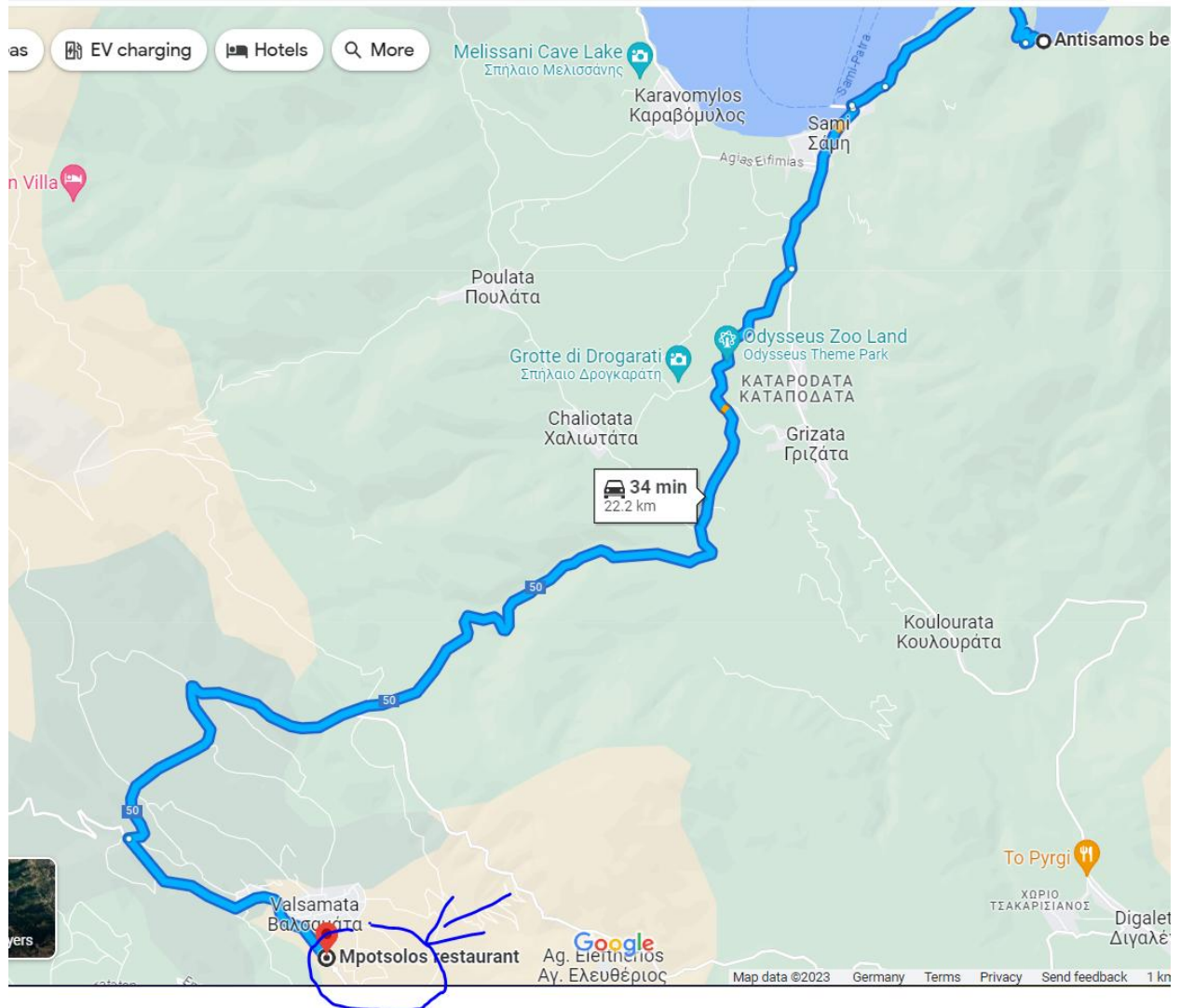
After Drogarati, head to **Melissani Cave**, which has become famous for its underground lake. You take a short boat ride inside the cave (around 10–15 minutes). If there's a long queue, I wouldn't recommend waiting an hour in the sun — it's best visited early in the morning when there are fewer people.



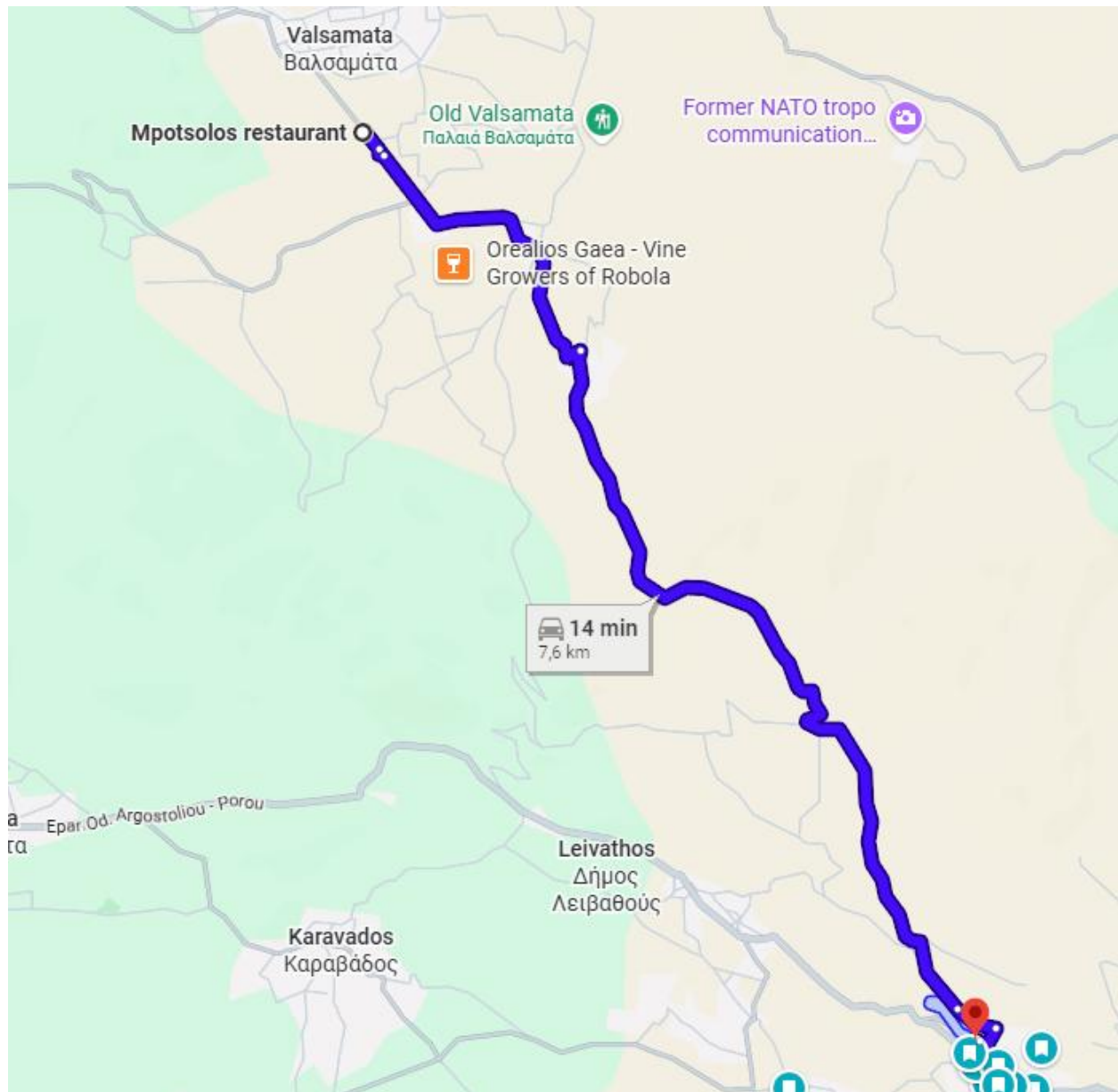
After that, it's time to relax and swim at **Antisamos Beach**. It's a beautiful beach with sunbeds, umbrellas, a beach bar, and options for food and water sports — perfect for spending the rest of the afternoon until evening.



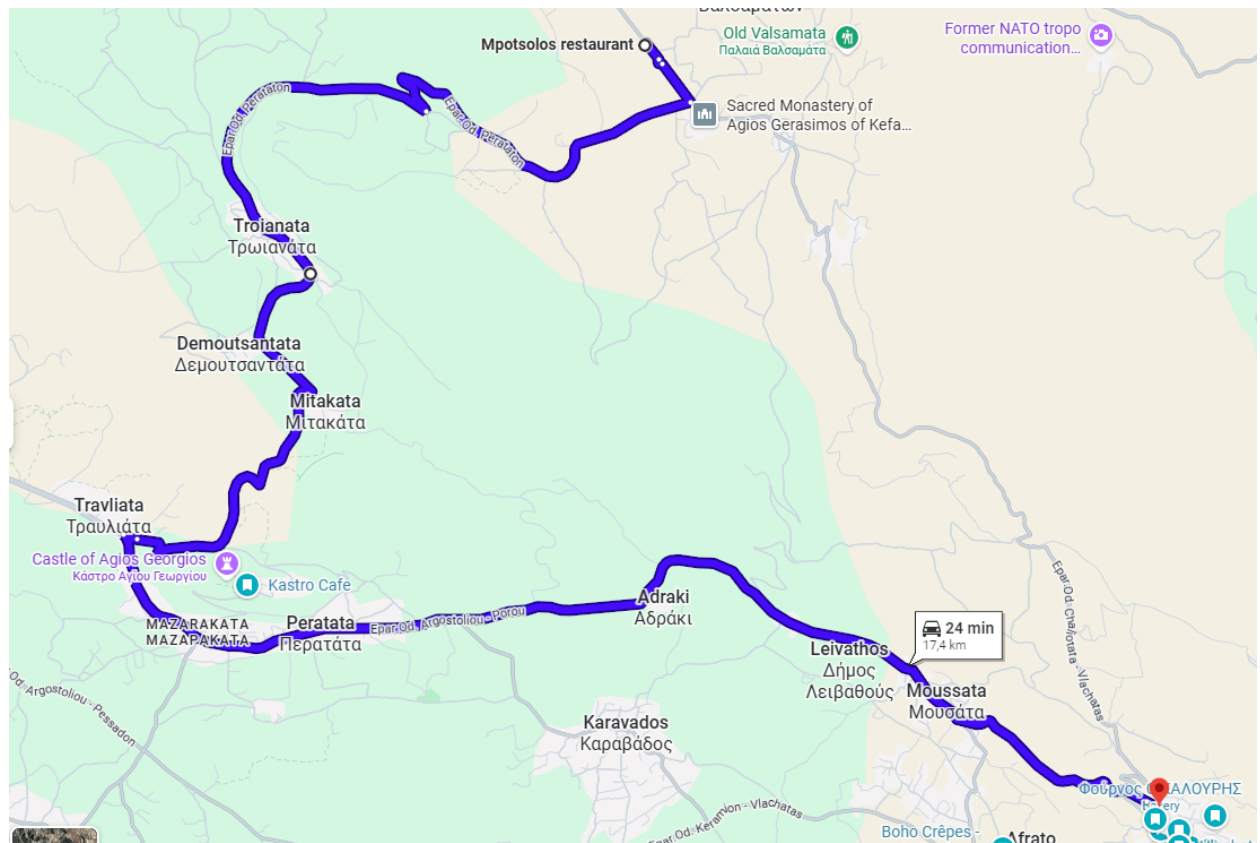
On your way back, treat yourself to a great meal. If you're in the mood for excellent local meat, I highly recommend **Botsolos Taverna**, near Agios Gerasimos. The quality of the local meat there is truly outstanding.



From Botsolos you take the road back to Trithea Villa if still not night:



If night already then take this road which is more main road not very local:

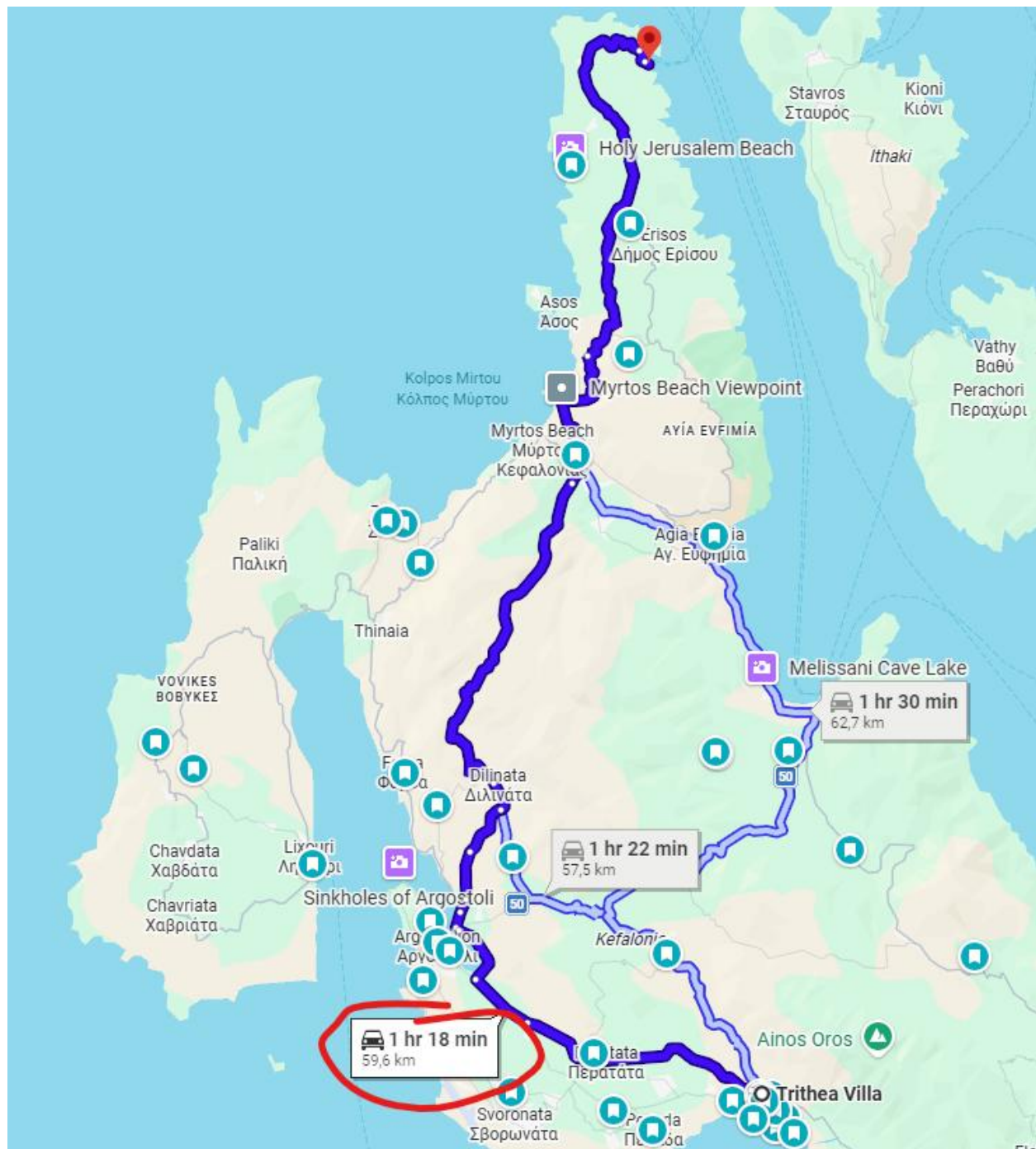


Proposal Day Trip 2 - Fiskardo, Assos and Myrtos

If you choose the **north Kefalonia route**, this is also a full-day trip. Leave **Trithea early in the morning** and plan to return in the evening.

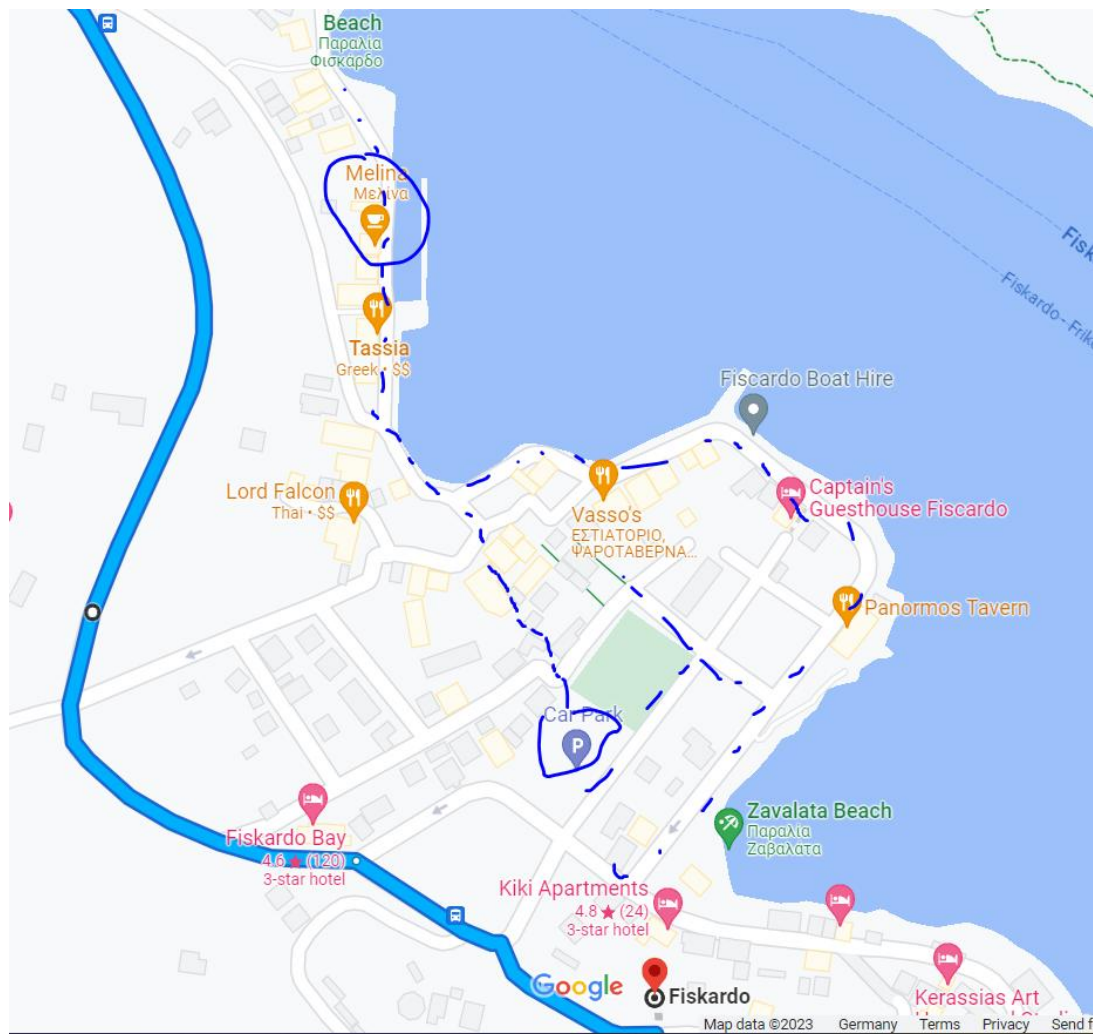
Many visitors make the mistake of starting with **Myrtos Beach**, but I don't recommend this, as it can be tiring and leave you exhausted before reaching **Fiskardo village**. Instead, start early and drive **directly to Fiskardo** via the scenic mountain road (which I'll indicate). The drive takes about **1 hour and 15 minutes**, but it's absolutely worth it for the views.

Once in Fiskardo, enjoy a relaxed morning coffee, take photos, and stroll around the picturesque harbor and village. Even though you'll pass **Myrtos Beach** on the way, resist the temptation to stop — it's best enjoyed **on the return journey**, when you'll have more time and energy to fully appreciate it.



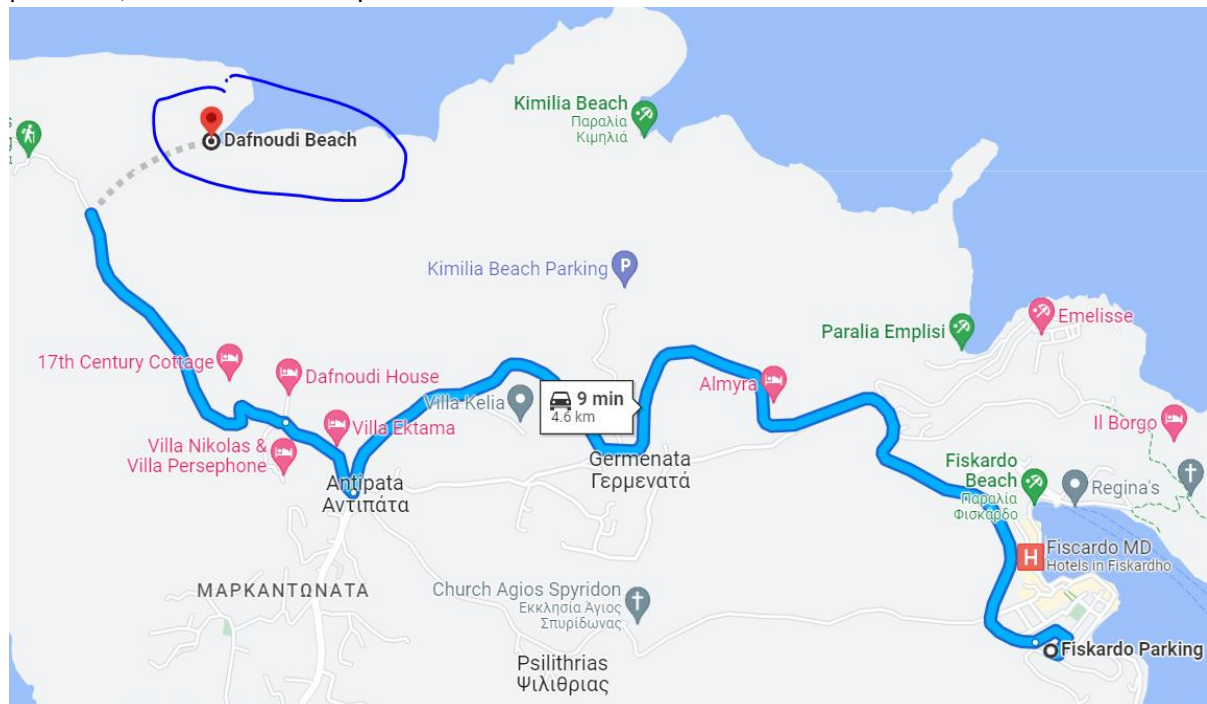
In the **Fiskardo** area, I recommend taking some time to walk around the village and enjoy a drink, dessert, or breakfast at **Melina's**. It's a great spot to relax, take photos, and do a bit of souvenir shopping before continuing your trip.

I wouldn't recommend having lunch there, as the prices are quite high and, in my opinion, the food doesn't offer good value for money.

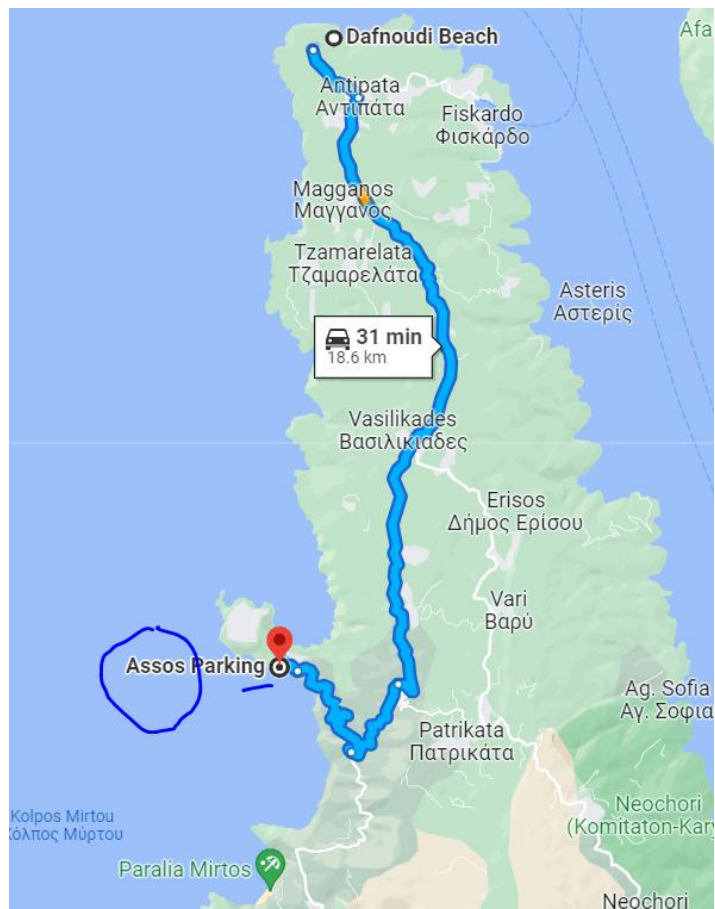


Take the car and head to **Dafnoudi Beach** for a quick swim. You'll leave the car along the road and then walk for a few minutes through a small forest to reach the beach. The walk is easy and

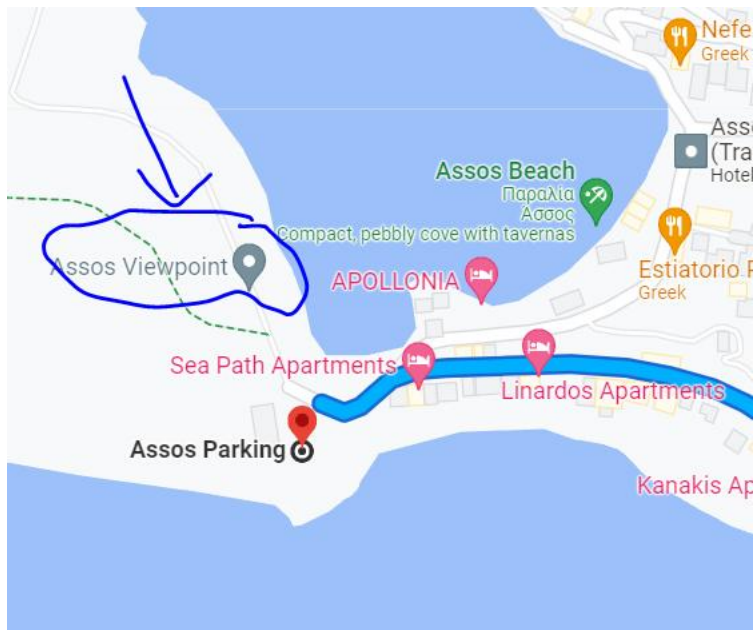
pleasant, and the beach is quiet and beautiful — well worth the short walk.



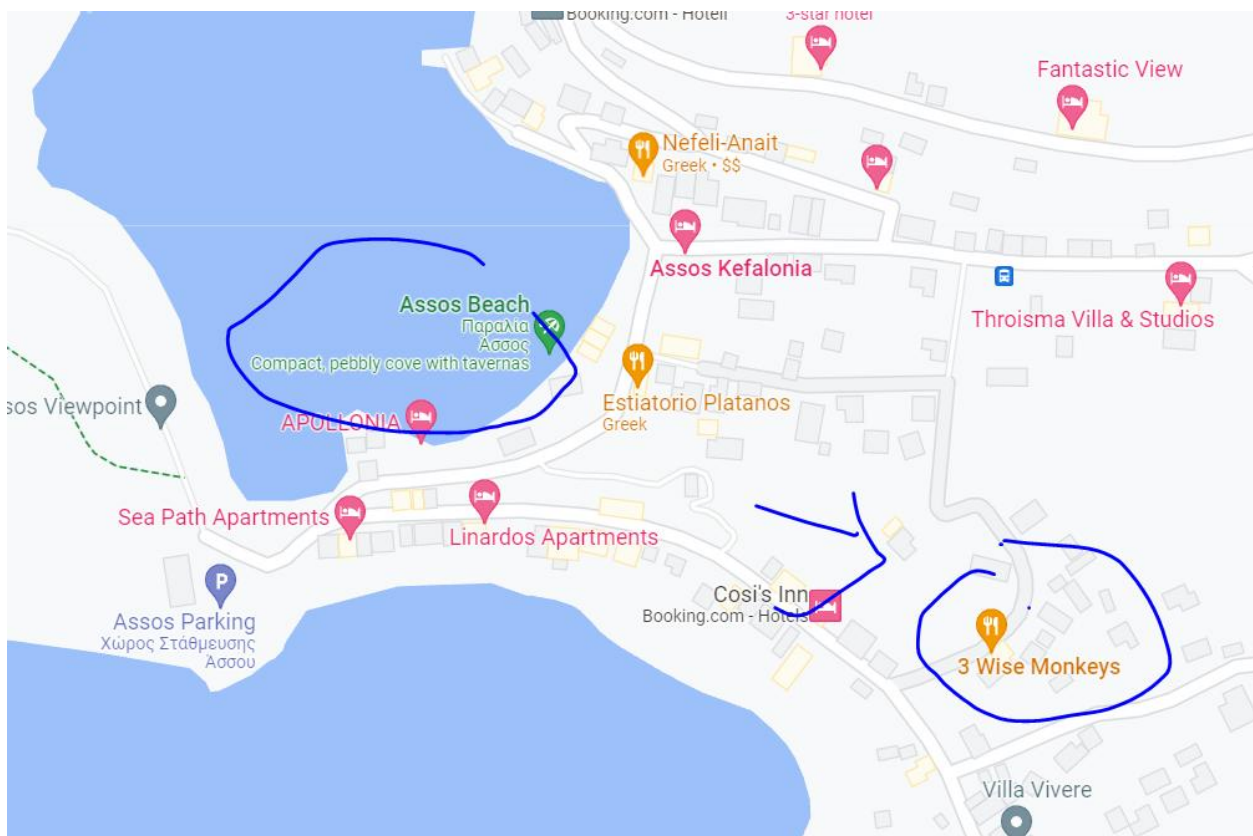
Time for lunch then ...you take the road to the village of Assos :



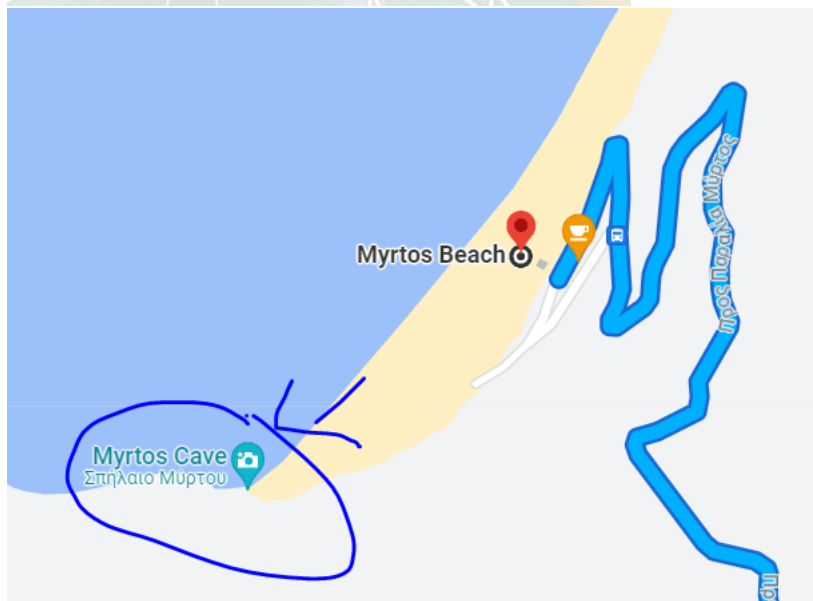
In **Assos**, I recommend taking a short walk along the road that leads up to the castle. There's no need to go all the way to the top — about halfway up you'll find a perfect spot for stunning photos, with **Assos Village** beautifully framed in the background.



On the way back to the village, if you wish, you can stop for a quick swim at the beach within the village. After that, you can enjoy a meal at one of the local restaurants — **this is the one I recommend.**



Then it's time to stop at **Myrtos Beach** to take photos, enjoy a swim, explore the small cave along the beach, watch the sunset, and finally return to your base.



Relax and take your time — walk to **Myrtos Cave** and enjoy the beach. **Do not leave without watching the sunset — this is a must!**

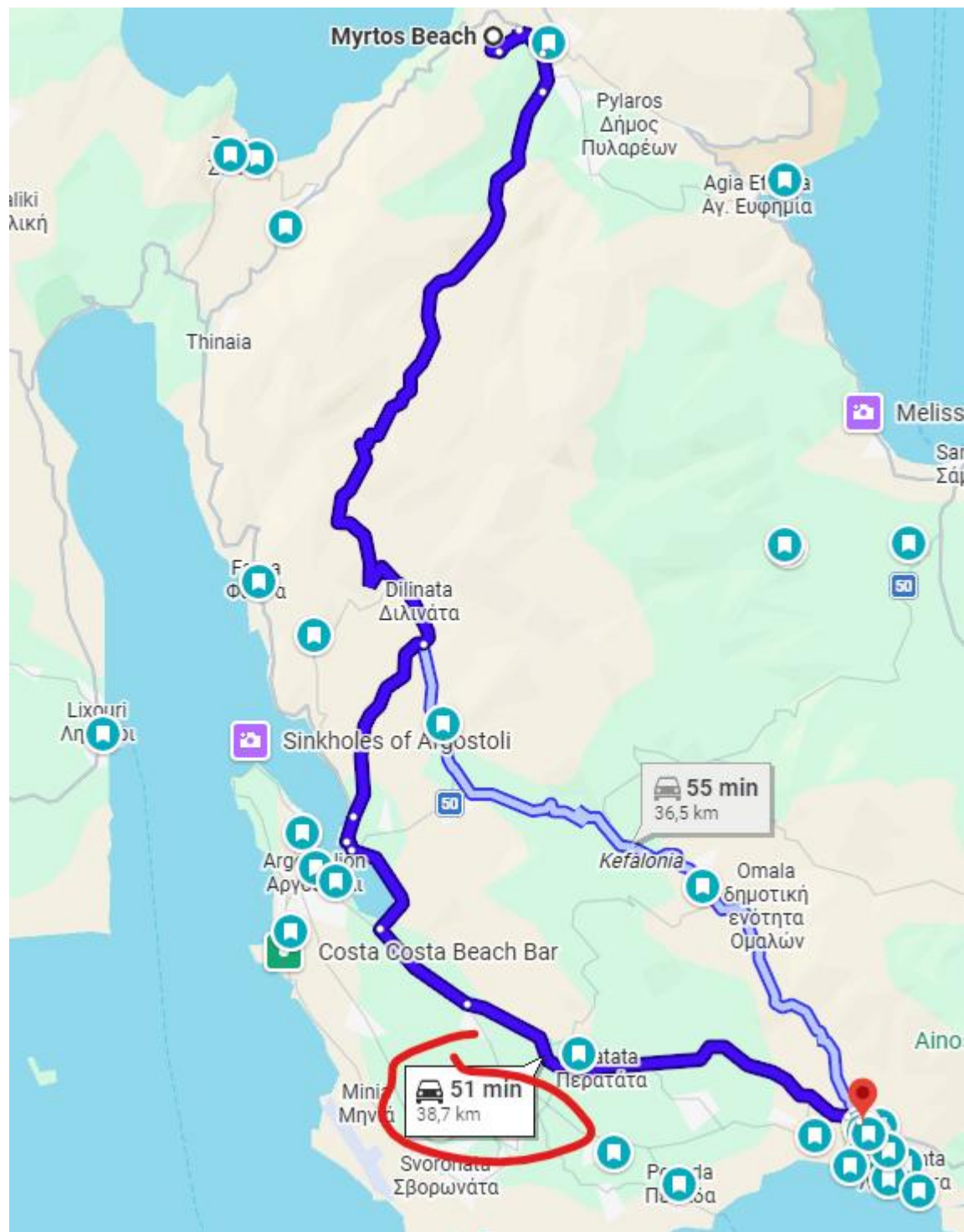
At Myrtos Beach usually you'll find **sunbeds, toilets, and a small beach bar**. However, each year it depends on the local municipality when they decide to open the bar.

Tip 1: It's a good idea to bring your own umbrella, snacks, and water, just in case.

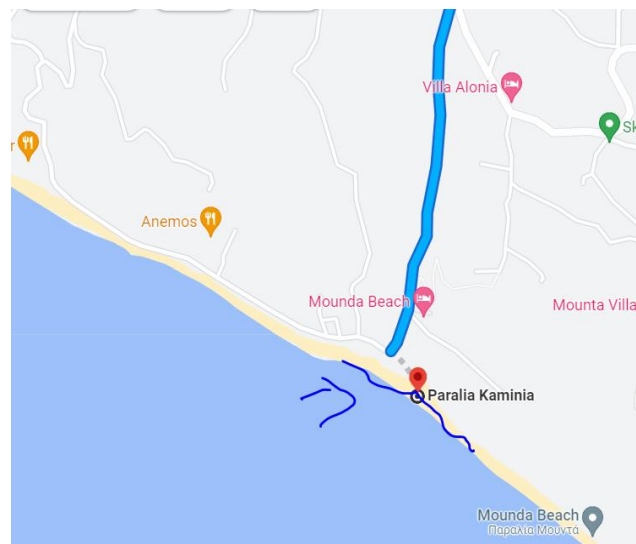
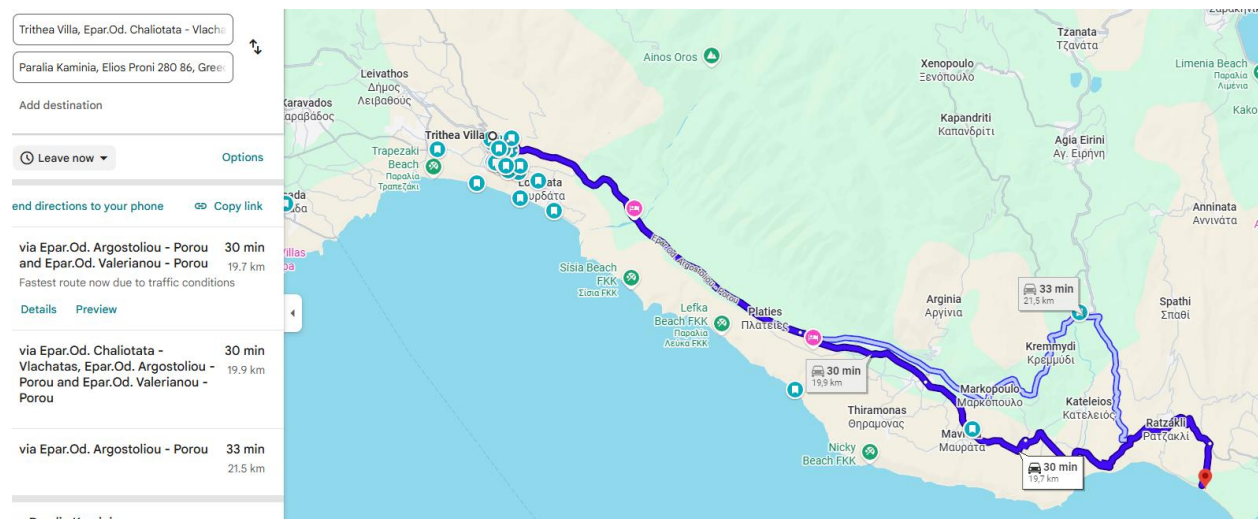
After sunset, take the road back to your base with the **sea on your right-hand side** (avoid the mountain road).



Proposal Day Trip 3

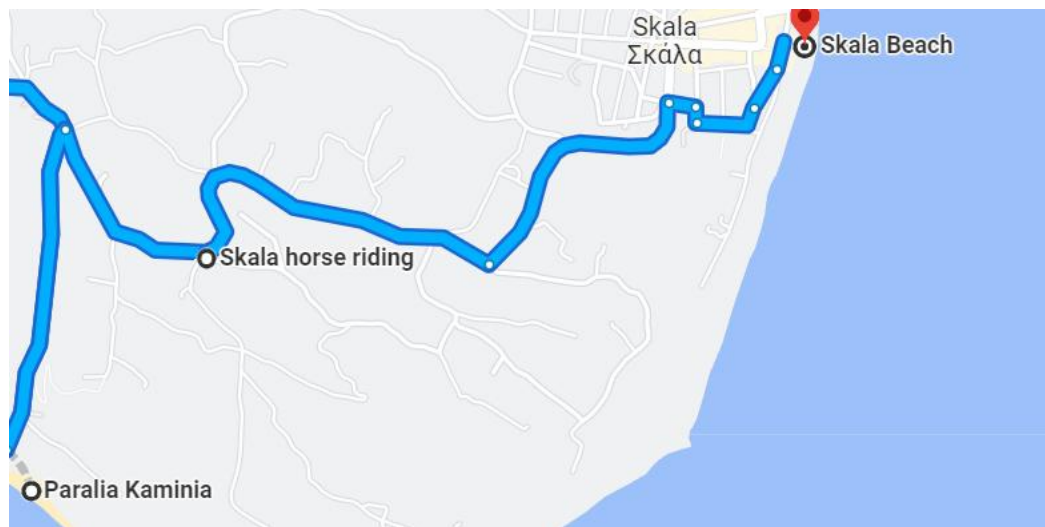
Day Trip to Skala/Poros area:

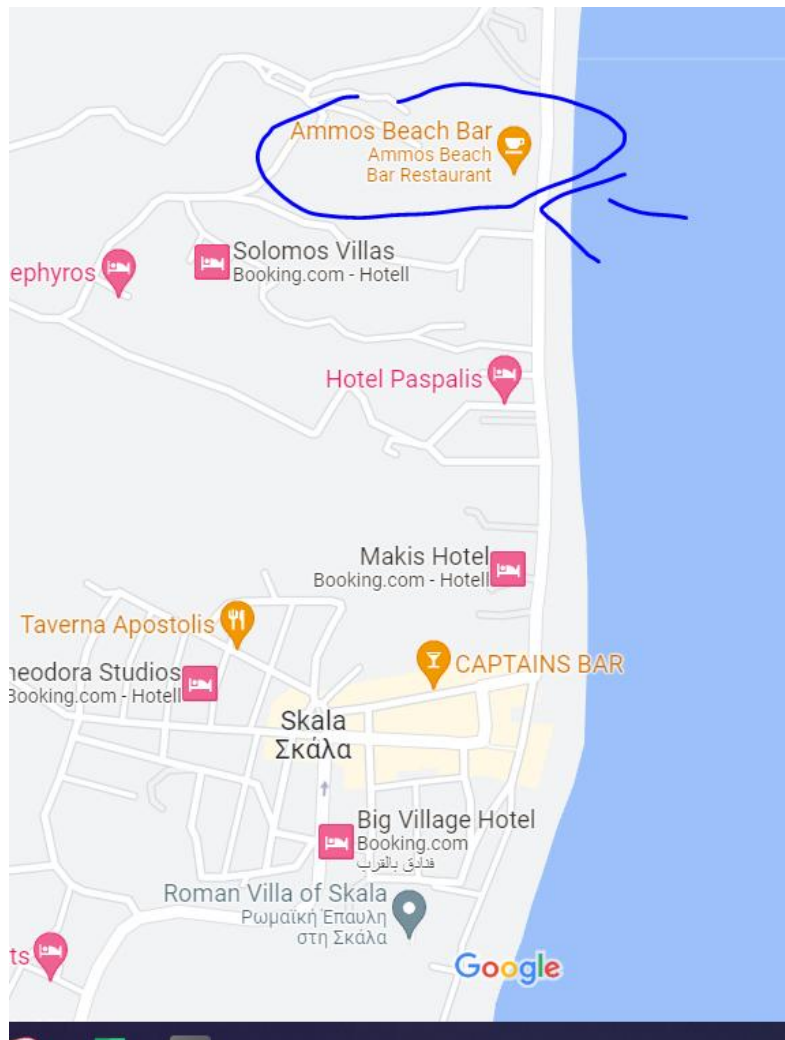

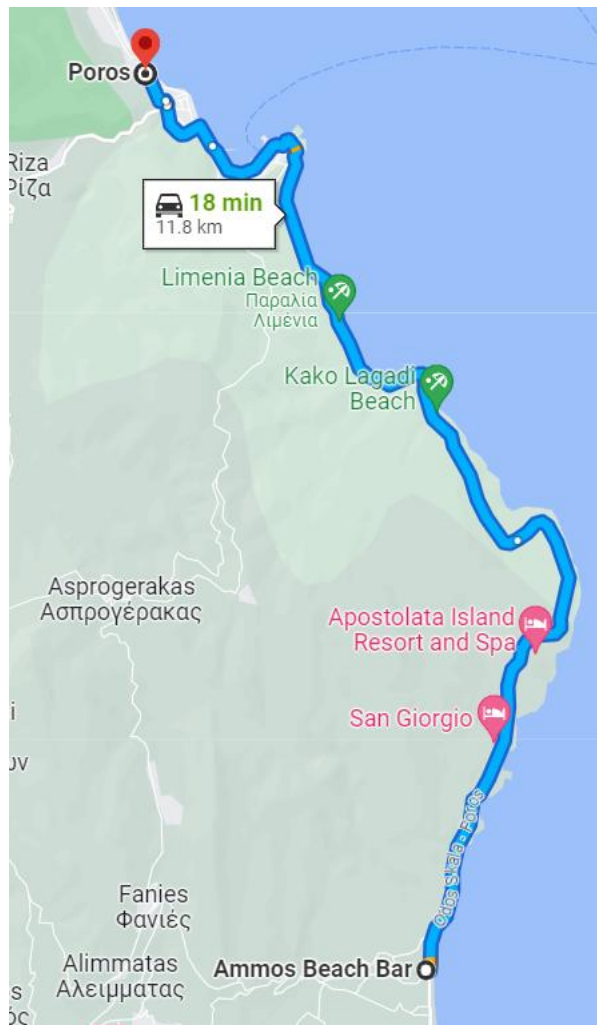


In Skala usually I go in the beach and have some clubs/drinks along with umbrellas and sunbeds near the sea ... I recommend Ammos Beach Bar

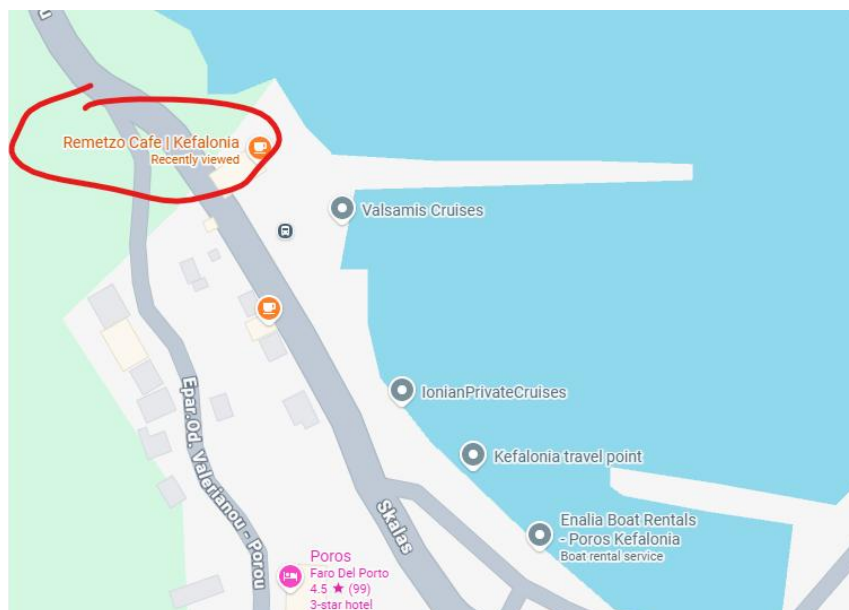

If there is time, then you can drive to Poros village



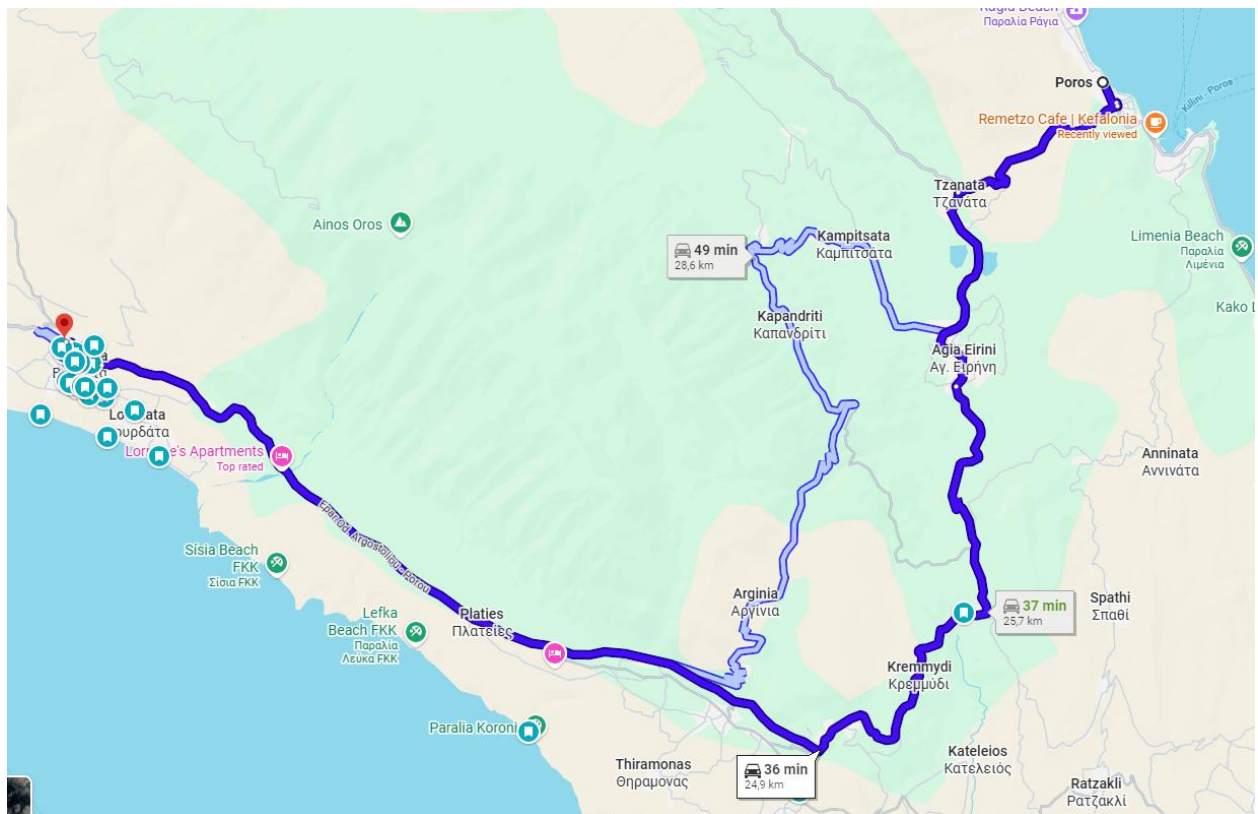
There is a nice Café there, Remetzo:

Proposal Day Trip 3

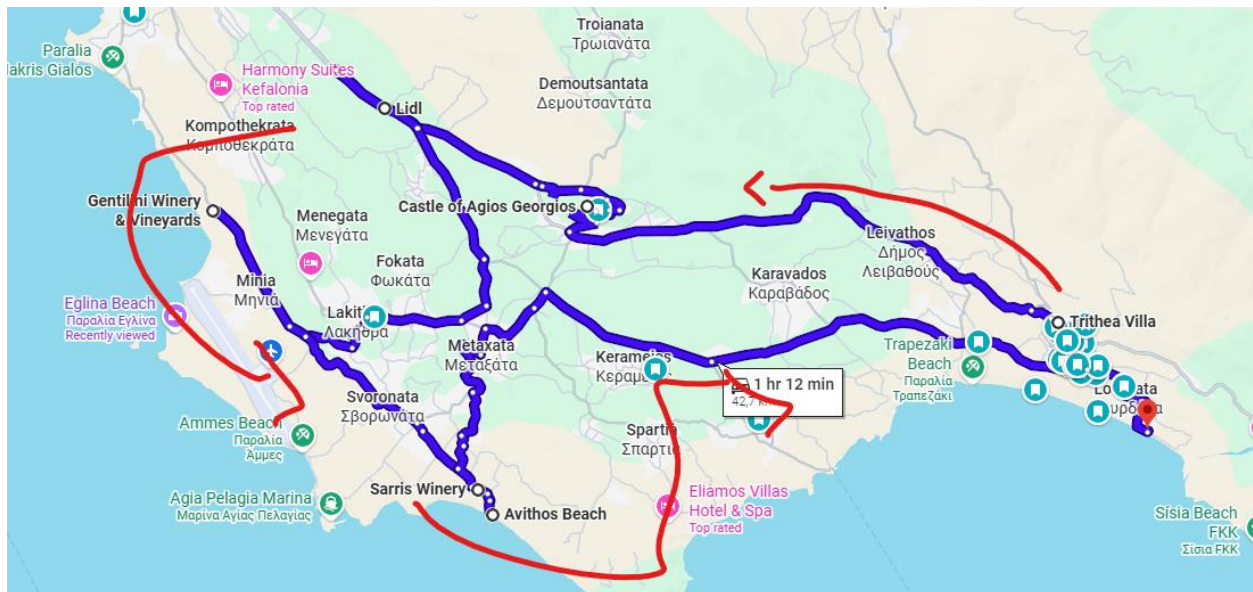
So one day trip is to explore **Livathos valley -area where Trithea is...it is a round trip**

And a nice Café –

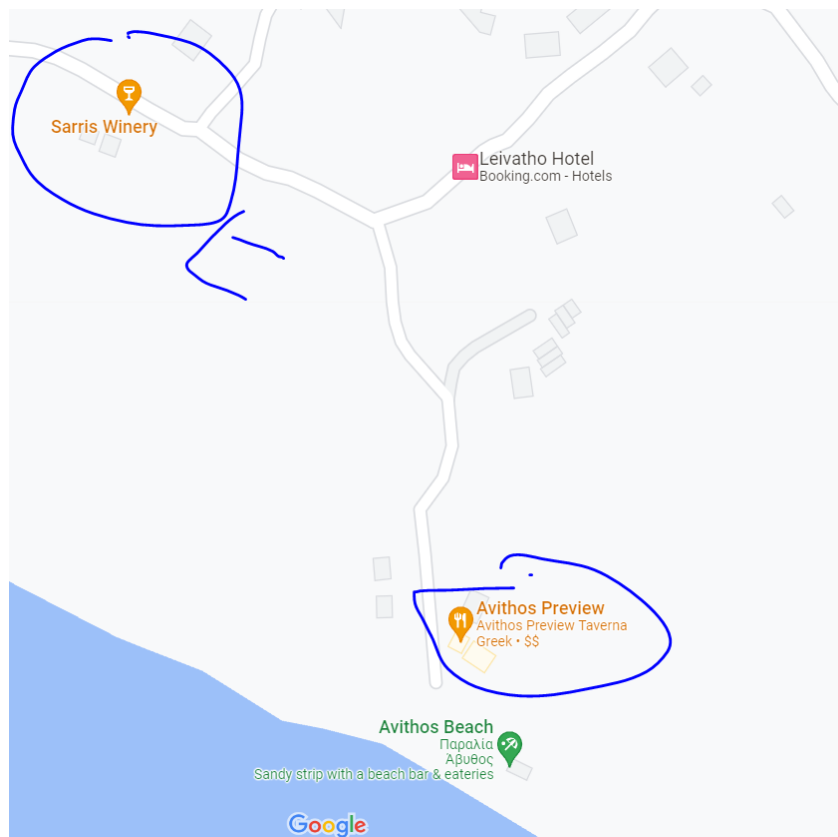
You then do some shopping from the big supermarkets (yes it does exist a big Lidl here as well) – AB or Kritikos are more expensive 😊

Gentilini winery if you want to taste good Kefalonian wine Robola.

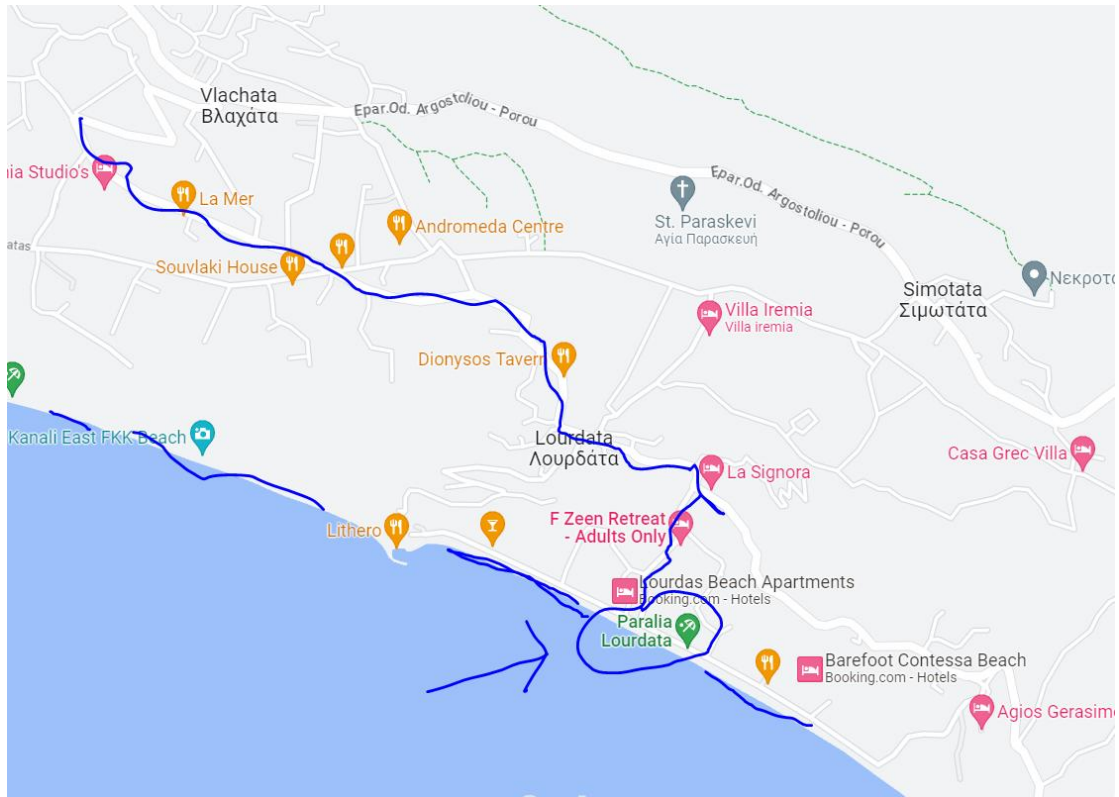
Going further to Avithos beach is recommended you visit Sarris winery ...they produce local Kefalonian wine Robola ... and they own the restaurant there



you then drive to village Vlachata from an another road ...

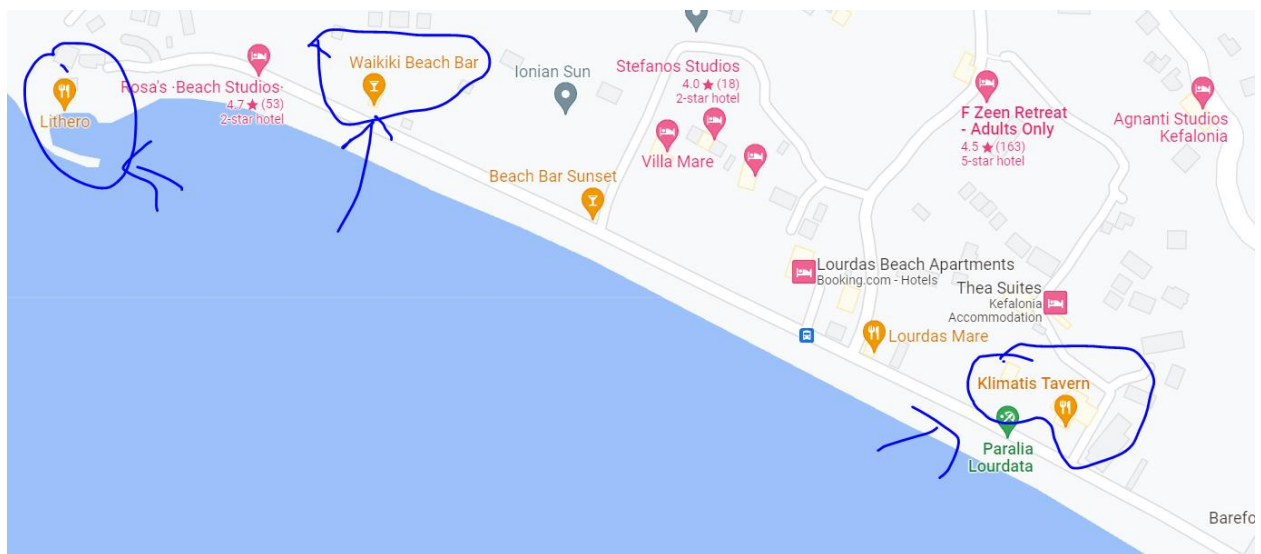
You park in Lourdas Beach there is a road on left and right ...

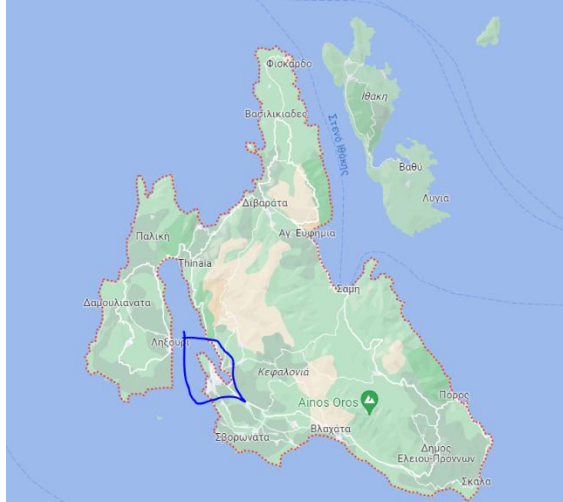

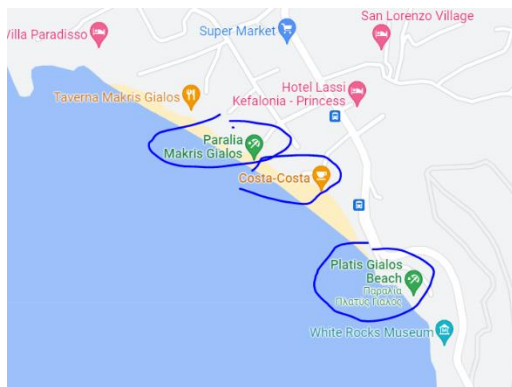

Lassi: You will go for swimming in Platis Yialos and Makris Yialos.



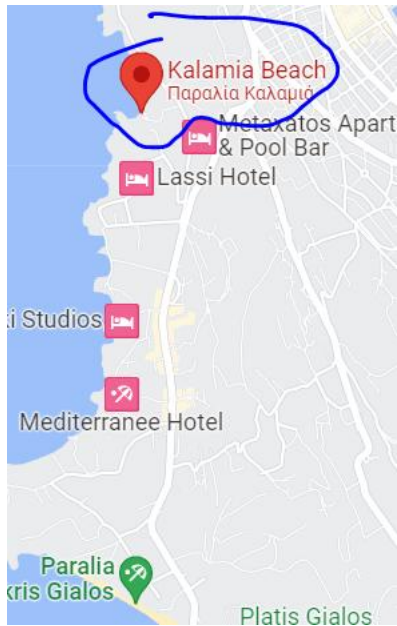

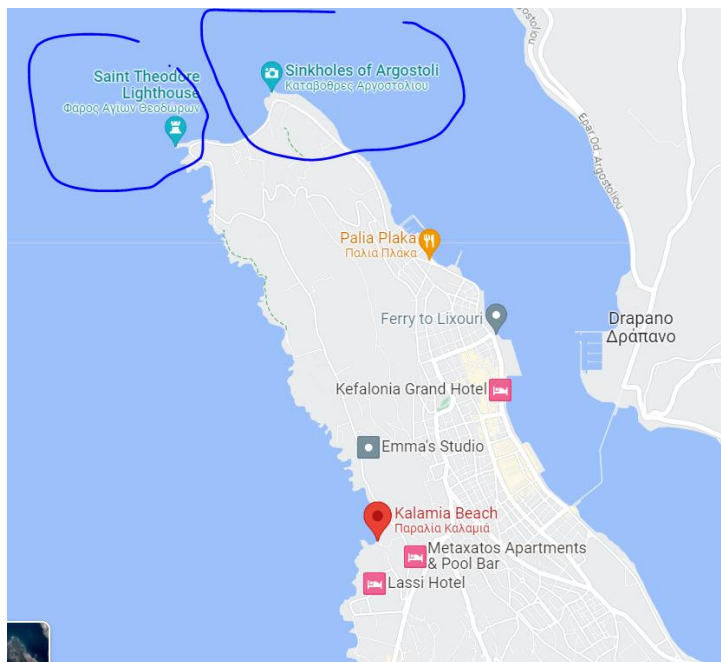
Near to Makris Gialos it is the Platis Gialos which is more friendly family- not so many people and there is enough space to place your own umbrella.

Both beaches are walking distance from Lassi so you can walk or there are parking areas where you can leave the car.

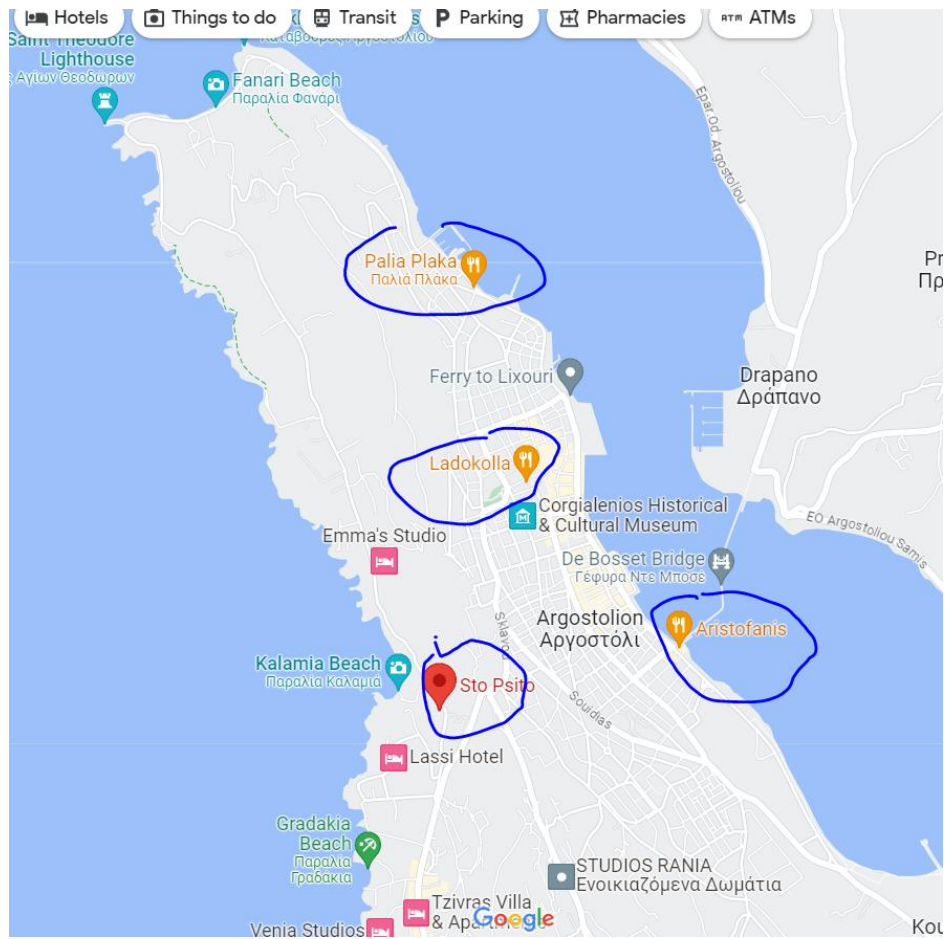
There is another one smaller beach that is worthing – mainly locals go there: Kalamia Beach

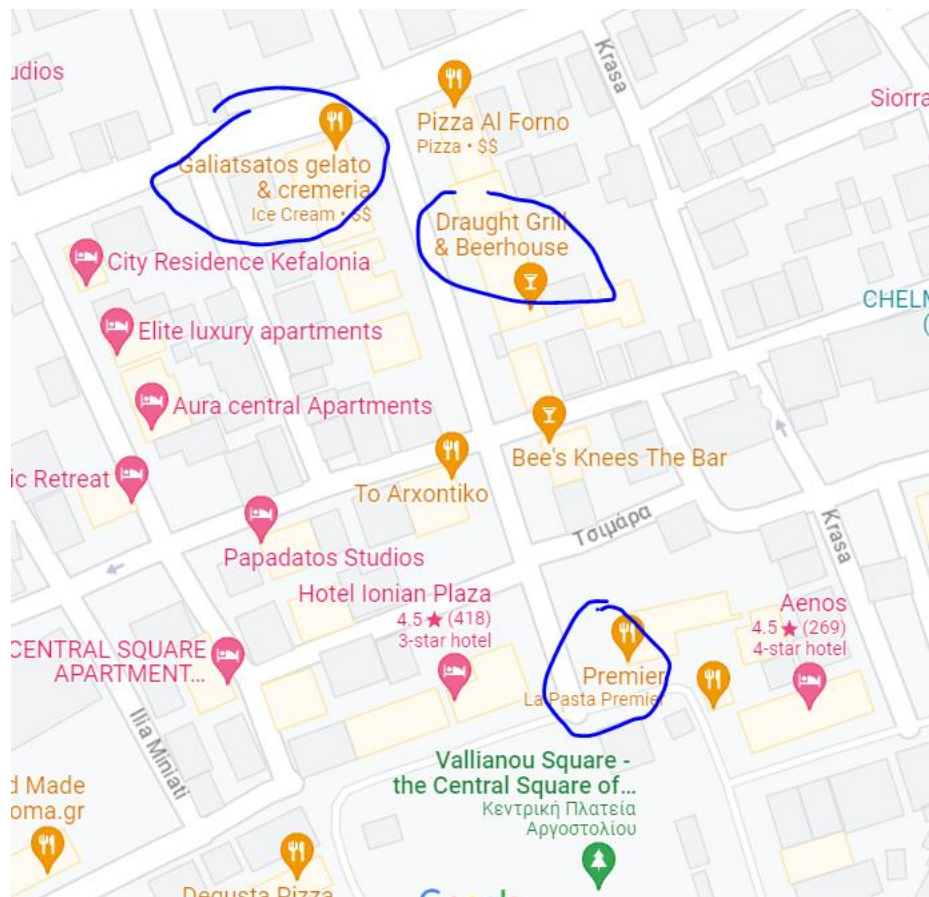


It is nothing doing a round with a car in Lassi area ,, , what we call it Lassi round where you can stop for photos in these areas

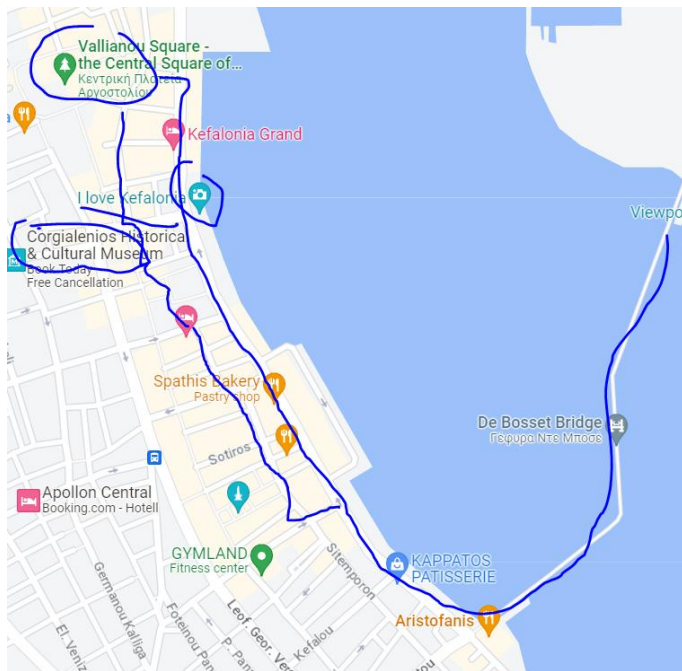


In area of Lassi the food is very touristic so I would recommended eating in below ones in Lassi or Argostoli





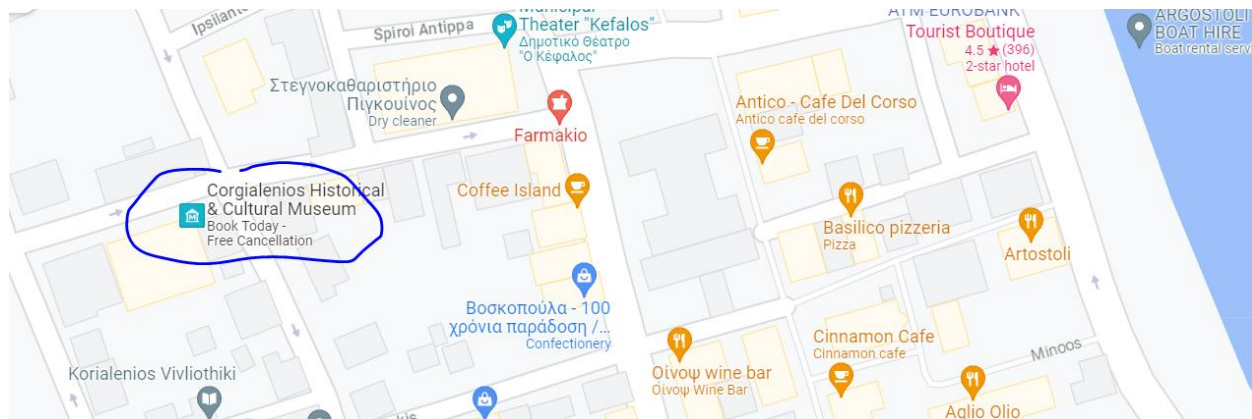

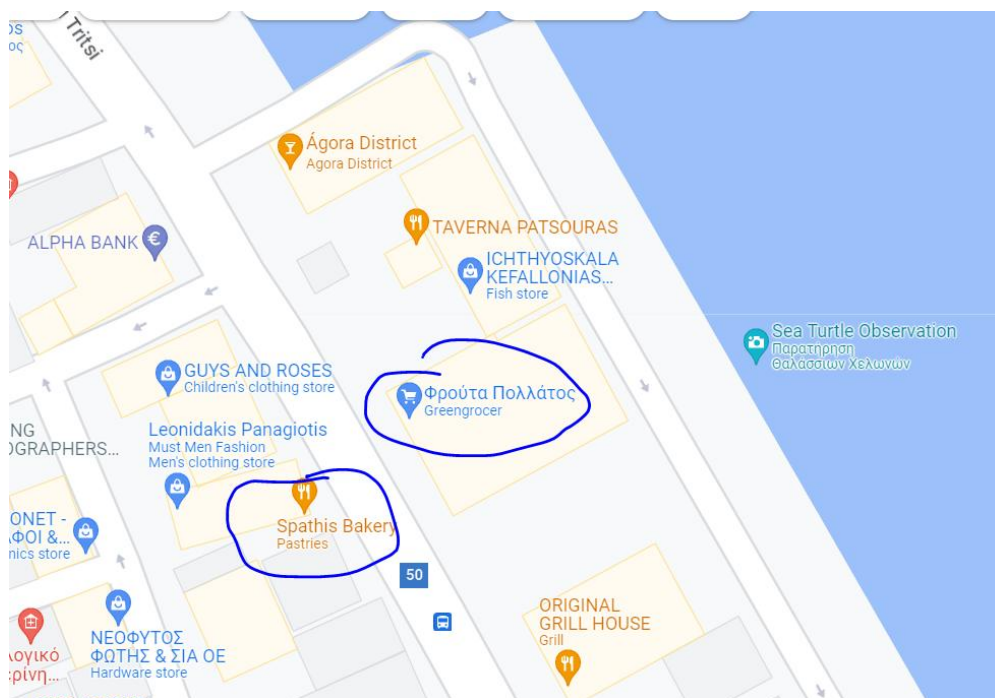
